EU Grants

ERC-2023-CoG consolidator grants

The European Commission Horizon Europe: Excellent Science European Research Council invites proposals for its ERC-2023-CoG consolidator grants. These enable researchers to consolidate their independence by establishing or strengthening a research team. Applications may be made in any field of research with an emphasis on the frontiers of science, scholarship and engineering.

PIs may may be of any nationality and based in any country at the time of application. They should have been awarded their PhD between seven and 12 years prior and must show evidence of research independent, for example by having produced several important publications as main author or without participation of their PhD supervisor. Host institutions must be established in EU members states or associated countries

The applicant does not need to be working at the institution at the time of application. Applicants must spend a minimum of 50 per cent of working time in an EU member state or associated country and a minimum of 40 per cent of their working time on the ERC project.

ERC-2023-ADG advanced grants

The European Commission Horizon Europe: Excellent Science European Research Council invites proposals for its ERC-2023-ADG advanced grants. These support established research leaders in conducting innovative research projects. Applications may be made in any field of research with an emphasis on the frontiers of science, scholarship and engineering.

Applicants may be researchers of any age or nationality, and may reside in any country at the time of the application. They must be active researchers with a track record of significant research achievements in the last ten years. They must spend a minimum of 50 per cent of working time in an EU member state or associated country and a minimum of 30 per cent of their working time on the ERC project. They must be engaged at the host institution for the duration of the project. Host institutions must be established in EU members states or associated countries.



The university ranking system changing

In order to take a deeper look at how universities approach the UN's SDGs, the questions for the "The Impact Rankings 2023" are refining and expanding.

The Impact Rankings team believe that internationalisation deeply strengthens universities. Knowledge is inherently global and the collaboration of people from different backgrounds makes for a better learning and research environment. To evaluate this, the following three metrics are currently used:

- Proportion of international students
- Proportion of international staff
- Proportion of publications with at least one co-author from an international institution

The University of Peradeniya will definitely score low on the first two metrices and therefore this is an appeal for our researchers to consider the third point seriously. Each of these metrics is worth 2.5 per cent of the overall score, meaning that internationalisation makes up 7.5 per cent in total.

They are also introducing a new measure to check internationalization. That is the number of students on international exchange programmes (essentially a measure of outbound student exchange). Considering the travel restrictions due to COVID 19, while universities are asked to provide data on outbound exchange students on a voluntary basis for WUR 2024, and the data will be validated and scored, the figures will be given zero weight in the final ranking calculation. However, the weights will be adjusted in the future. **Therefore, we have time to react to this and all academic programmes can seriously consider student exchange programmes.**

The Impact Rankings team is also considering a new normalization. Large countries – some of which may be home to many diverse cultures – are at a big disadvantage when compared with smaller countries and regions. Students can travel hundreds of kilometres in the US and still be in the same country. That is a luxury that doesn't exist in Luxembourg or Qatar or many smaller nations. The result: it is "easier" for universities in Luxembourg and Qatar to do well in these measures. To deal with this challenge, it was decided to introduce a new type of normalisation that will take into account the size of the country. There are several ways of measuring a country's size. However, as the capacity of higher education is largely guided by the country's overall population, it will be used for normalization. There is also a question of how to use the population values. The sizes of populations of different countries vary widely – from 1.4 billion in China to 650,000 in Luxembourg. As applying for these numbers directly to the metric calculation, would skew the scores far too much, they will use the logarithm of the population.
