Research grants

These grants support research that addresses knowledge gaps in the field of leukodystrophies. Preference is given to clinical trials and clinical trial readiness projects.

Themes proposed in the 2023 call for proposals will focus on unmet needs in the field of leukodystrophies.

Research Topics of Interest include:

- Clinical trial / clinical trial readiness for leukodystrophies including the development of longitudinal outcome measures, biomarker characterization, imaging modalities and pharmacodynamics /pharmacokinetic studies.
- Preclinical studies specifically testing therapies (gene, cell, enzyme or pharmacologic therapies) for leukodystrophies.
- Developing animal or cell-based models (e.g. patient derived iPSC) relevant to human leukodystrophies.
- Study of mechanisms responsible for leukodystrophies, in order to identify new therapeutic approaches.

Environment fund - tropical rainforests

The Waterloo Foundation invites applications for its environment fund - tropical rainforests grants. These support projects protecting tropical rain forest, principally through avoided deforestation. Examples of eligible projects include:

exposing, addressing and overcoming the local drivers of deforestation;

management of the specified area;

methods to measure and monitor the protected area;

·sustainable livelihoods for forest-dependent communities

working on international or regional forest policy;

campaigning for improved practices in commerce addressing the drivers of deforestation;

innovative ways of reducing deforestation, such as financial systems or solutions based on the value of forest ecosystem services.

Preference is given to initiatives working to protect tropical rainforests for their value to the climate, communities and biodiversity, principally through avoided deforestation. The funder will consider both practical local projects, and strategic initiatives.

Applications are preferred from UK-based charities. Organisations based outside the UK may be eligible if they meet certain criteria.

Grants are usually worth between £50,000 and £100,000 each for up to three years.

GLOBAL 3R AWARDS

This program recognizes significant innovative contributions toward the 3Rs of animal research to advance ethical science, by any researcher (nominated author, principal investigator, or research team leader) in academia or industry in any area of biology (e.g., basic science, discovery, development, teaching, testing, manufacture for new medicines, vaccines, medical devices or healthcare products for humans and animals). Award nominations must be based on a primary research paper that advances any of the 3Rs (i.e., the Refinement, Replacement or Reduction of animal use) and is published in a peer-reviewed journal in the last three (3) years. These may include modifications to existing research techniques or any innovative research approach including, but not limited to: improvements to whole-animal models, tissue-based models (e.g., cell lines, tissue cultures), molecular techniques (e.g., proteomics), analytic and computational models, study design or technique refinements (e.g., sampling technologies, improved test methods), and translational medicine applications. Meta-analyses that develop fundamental new insights into the 3Rs are also eligible, but the methodology must be described within the paper as this is one of the scoring criteria.

Proposals addressing CVD and Cardiometabolic disorders are encouraged. Included are proposals that address pathophysiology, molecular genetics, metabolic abnormalities leading to cardiovascular disease, hypertension, heart failure, hyperlipidemia, inflammatory mechanisms and new pathways for drug discovery. Proposals focusing on clinically relevant outcomes as a result of the metabolic syndrome, diabetes or obesity are also encouraged. Outcomes studies should focus on clinical/and or systems of care (e.g., quality improvement) interventions, and use outcomes measures of importance to both patients and society, including mortality, significant morbidity or quality of life changes, or economic effects.

Preference for one award will be given to applicants focusing on disparities of care. Despite increased attention to health disparities at the national, state and community levels, relatively little progress has been made in achieving the vision of eliminating racial and ethnic health disparities. Since the rates of cardiovascular mortality in the United States are significantly higher for these patients and this is in fact the leading cause of death in this demographic, innovative approaches to eliminating these disparities are critical. In an effort to encourage and support research in this area, proposals will be encouraged that focus on gender, race, geographic, and economic inequalities in cardiovascular care.

URC Research Awards – 2023

1. Introduction

To acknowledge and incentivize outstanding research and creative achievements within the past year, the University Research Council (URC) of the University of Peradeniya (UoP) establishes the URC Research Awards. These awards will celebrate the contributions of researchers who have significantly advanced their fields and motivate further research endeavours across the university.

2. Types of Awards:

There are two types of awards, namely:

- i. URC Research Award for the outstanding researcher (Tier 1)
- ii. URC Research Award for the outstanding researcher (Tier2)

A certificate and a plaque will be awarded.

3. Eligibility for Awards:

General Criteria:

To be eligible for an award, the candidate MUST comply with the following eligibility criteria, in general:

- A permanent member of the UoP.
- Publications, patents, and other achievements considered for the award must be from January to December of the award year.
- Should have at least one Indexed Journal [see: Section 4(a) below].
- Manuscripts that are accepted but not published will not be considered but articles that are published with a DOI number but have not been allocated to an issue will be considered.
- In all publications and works submitted for evaluation, the applicant's primary affiliation must be clearly stated as 'University of Peradeniya'.
- The publications presented in the symposia for undergraduate programs at UoP are not eligible for consideration.

1. URC will appoint a 3-member committee to evaluate the applications and to select the winners which will be presented to the MC of the URC for approval

Recognition awards of research grant recipients – 2023

These grants are established to recognize research grant recipients in the year 2023. The following matrices are used to decide these recognition grants

1. Grant Award Amount:

- Total Amount: This metric provides a direct indication of the scale and perceived value of the research by funding agencies.
- Distribution: Evaluate the balance between national and international grants, indicating the researcher's reach and competitiveness.

2. Grant Source Prestige:

- Tiering of National Grants: Classify national grants based on their prestige or difficulty in securing, weighting them accordingly.
- Reputational Ranking of International Agencies: Use established rankings like SCImago Institutions Rankings or Leiden Ranking to assign points based on the grant agency's international standing.

3. Grant Type:

- Principal Investigator (PI) vs. Co-Investigator: Assign a higher weight to grants where the researcher is the PI, demonstrating leadership and responsibility.
- Individual vs. Collaborative Grants: Consider the balance between individual and collaborative grants, providing insight into the researcher's independence and ability to work with others.

Eligibility criteria:

- To be eligible, the granted research project must list the University of Peradeniya as the institutional affiliation for the researcher(s).
- Research grants must be currently active and have been running for at least three months as of January 1st of the application year.
- The funded research project's completion date must fall after June 30th of the year the grant will be awarded.

The following grants are not eligible:

- Capacity building grants
- Grants outside the time windows specified above

Normalization:

Eligible total mark is based on the researcher's career stage and the field of study to ensure fair comparison. The following table specifies the total marks required:

Research Publication Facilitation Fund University Of Peradeniya

The new application for Research Publication Facilitation application is now available in <u>https://site.pdn.ac.lk/centers/urc</u>

According to the new process introduced for the reimbursement of Article processing charges, applicants can get prior approval for the payments before submission of the application. Upon receiving the approval for the APC from URC, usually through an email, submit the invoice for the payment of the APC, and the credit card statement to process the payment.

Note:

- Application is a fillable form, which you can fill using Adobe Acrobat Reader latest versions.
- Furnish all the details, sign the application, get the Head and the Dean to sign.
- Attach a copy of the complete manuscript and the acceptance letter.
- Only the full-length articles published in SCI/SSCI/SCIexpanded/SSCI-expanded with an impact factor of 1 or higher will be considered for RPFF
- If the impact factor is greater than or equal to 1 and less than 2, USD 500 per author up to a maximum of USD 1000 per paper per year.
- If the impact factor is greater than or equal to 2, USD 500 per author up to a maximum of USD 1500 per paper per year.

Special Note:

- The payment must be done by a permanent staff member of the University of Peradeniya.
- If two authors claim for the same article fill in two separate applications and send both applications together (Attaching one copy of the manuscript and the invoice is adequate). If one author paid for the APC, a consent letter from the second author should be submitted.
- Funding is subjected to availability of funds.



Research Publication Facilitation Fund University of Peradeniya

The University Research Council [URC] is pleased to announce that it has initiated a scheme to provide financial assistance up to a maximum of **USD 1500.00** per year for the researchers of the University of Peradeniya to facilitate publishing their research findings in high ranking peer-reviewed journals.

Publishing research findings in reputed journals inevitably increases the visibility of research work and thereby it brings reputation and publicity for the researchers as well as for the university. Therefore, encouraging researchers to publish their scholarly work in reputed highimpact journals is of paramount importance. Publishing in many high-impact international peer reviewed journals involves page charges amounting to USD 2500 or even more, especially if the researcher intends to publish as an open access article. Publishing as an open access article invariably enhances the visibility of the research work leading to high number of citations.

Assisting researchers with their publications has been a long-felt need at Peradeniya. Providing assistance for researchers in getting their research work in high impact journals has been identified as one of the priorities in establishing the University Research Council. Accordingly, the URC takes pleasure in enhancing the Publication support to our researchers from January 2023

- Attach a copy of the complete manuscript and the acceptance letter.
- · And send the application to URC before paying the Article Processing Charge (APC) for approval and necessary processing.

Financial assistance

- Only the full-length articles published in SCI/SSCI/SCI-expanded/SSCI-expanded with an impact factor of 1 or higher will be considered for RPFF
- If the impact factor is greater than or equal to 1 and less than 2, USD 500 per author up to a maximum of USD 1000 per paper per year.
- If the impact factor is greater than or equal to 2, USD 500 per author up to a maximum of USD 1500 per paper per year.

Eligibility criteria

 Applicant: The applicant should be a permanent staff member of University of Peradeniya and one of the authors of the journal article

Affiliation: University of Peradeniya should have been identified as the sole affiliation or one of the affiliations. Journal articles which do not carry University of Peradeniya as an affiliation are not eligible for funding.

• Research work: Research should have been carried out fully or in part at University of Peradeniya. Research work carried out by a permanent staff member of University of Peradeniya completely outside of University of Peradeniya may also be eligible.

• The use of Institutional e-mail address: The author/s affiliated to University of Peradeniya are encouraged to use the official e-mail address with pdn domain name provided by University of Peradeniya in correspondence with the journal. If the applicant is the corresponding author of the journal article the author should have used the institutional e-mail address.

Journal: The journal should be indexed in SCI/SSCI or SCI-expanded/SSCI-expanded journal with a journal impact of 1 or higher.
Frequency: Once a calendar year.

Payment

The payment must be done by a permanent staff member of the University of Peradeniya

• Upon receiving the approval for the APC from URC, usually through an email, submit the invoice for the payment of the APC, and the credit card statement to process the payment.

• If two authors claim for the same article fill in two separate applications and send both applications together (Attaching one copy of the manuscript and the invoice is adequate). If one author paid for the APC, a consent letter from the second author should be submitted.

Others

The URC reserves the right to amend the selection criteria

• The article processing charge will be reimbursed subject to the availability of funds.
