# Peradeniya University International Research Sessions 2023 'Navigating the New Frontiers - Exploring Opportunities'

**Date: September 20th-21st, 2023**

**Venue: Postgraduate Institute of Science and University of Peradeniya**

Peradeniya University International Research Sessions, commonly known as iPURSE, successfully convened for its annual event from September 20th to 21st, 2023. The event brought together scholars, researchers, and academics from across the globe to explore and share insights on a wide array of topics. The conference comprised an inaugural ceremony on September 20th, held at the Postgraduate Institute of Science, and faculty research sessions conducted on various venues across the university on September 21st.

The inaugural session, held at the Postgraduate Institute of Science on September 20th, was graced by the presence of eminent dignitaries. The Chief Guest for this grand occasion was Vidya Jyothi Prof. Chandra Wickramasinghe, a luminary in the field of science. Prof. Arun Chokalingam from the University of Toronto, a distinguished scholar in his own right, was the Guest of Honour, adding to the grandeur of the event. The presence of the Vice-Chancellor, Deputy Vice-Chancellor, Deans, Directors, and esteemed invitee guests further elevated the importance of this event. The keynote address during the inaugural session was delivered by Prof. Ajith de Alwis from the University of Moratuwa, whose expertise shed light on the conference theme.

6. Managerial Turn in Higher Education: The Issues and Challenges for Human Existence (47 abstracts)

The primary objective of iPURSE 2023 was to facilitate robust interactions between research students and early career academics with their more established counterparts. This platform provided an ideal setting for intellectual exchange, enabling participants to discuss and share their current research, thereby fostering collaboration and the expansion of knowledge in these diverse fields of study.

Researchers from various corners of the globe came together to address critical issues, propose innovative solutions, and navigate the new frontiers of knowledge. 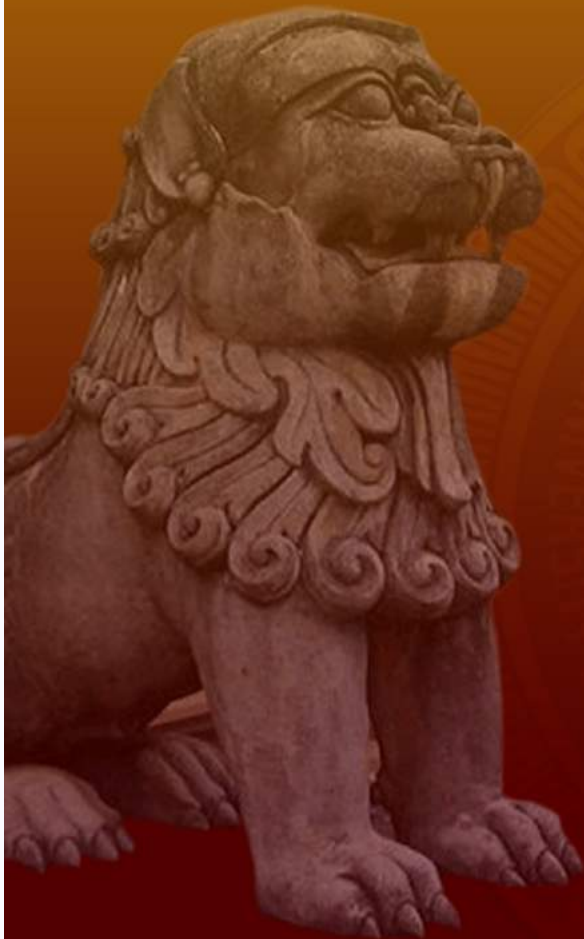

A publicly available database of top-cited scientists that provides standardized information on citations, h-index, co-authorship adjusted hm-index, citations to papers in different authorship positions and a composite indicator (c-score) is now published at

The selection is based on the top 100,000 scientists by c-score (with and without self-citations) or a percentile rank of 2% or above in the sub-field. This version (6) is based on the October 1, 2023 snapshot from Scopus, updated to end of citation year 2022.

## **Call For Proposals: Gairdner Ontario Programs**

The Gairdner Foundation, in partnership with the Krembil Foundation, is working to promote excellence and involvement in science in the province of Ontario. They are issuing an open call to all scientific organizations, research institutions and universities in the fields of human biology and medicine for events to be held next year.

Programs should fit into one of the three following streams:

1. Celebrating Excellence Stream: Programs that focus on recent scientific advances and bring extraordinary international science to Ontario, while highlighting the excellence of Ontario researchers. Potential programs would largely be stand-alone scientific symposia on a current and growing area of human biology and medicine. We encourage the inclusion of public and student engagement at these events as well.
2. Public Engagement Stream: Programs that translate extraordinary science into innovative, engaging and relevant programs for a lay audience, and encourage the growth of science culture and literacy in Canada. ## **AHA Data Grant: Debiasing Clinical Care Algorithms**

The purpose of this Request for Proposal is to reevaluate risk prediction models and algorithms in the field of cardiovascular and stroke science that have been adjusted for race. One such example is the Pooled Cohort Equation for atherosclerotic cardiovascular disease. The Pooled Cohort Equation predicts 10-year risk for a first atherosclerotic cardiovascular disease event.

In the process of reevaluating the use of race in risk prediction models and algorithms, a researcher might assess the complex interactions among ancestry, race, racism, socioeconomic status and the environment. A researcher may focus on whether removal of race in a clinical algorithm relieves or exacerbates inequities.

Examples of topics that would be responsive to this RFP include:

1. Assessing whether removal of race in a clinical algorithm relieves or exacerbates inequities.
2. Assessing potential bias in clinical published algorithms that include race, correcting for the bias, and identifying factors for the bias.
3. Developing statistical methods and advanced models that mitigate the bias in clinical published algorithms to support equitable care and treatment

Innovative Veterinary Solutions for Antimicrobial Resistance (InnoVet-AMR) is a four-year, CAD26.3 million partnership between IDRC and the UK Department of Health and Social Care (DHSC). The initiative is aimed at reducing the emerging risk that antimicrobial resistance (AMR) in animals poses to global health and food security.

Through InnoVet-AMR, IDRC and DHSC aim to achieve two main objectives:

- Support research that will identify and develop prophylactic and therapeutic innovative veterinary solutions, including vaccines, to improve health, while reducing the use of antimicrobials in ruminants and aquaculture operations in low- and middle-income countries (LMICs).

## Research Publication Facilitation Fund University Of Peradeniya

The new application for Research Publication Facilitation application is now available in <https://site.pdn.ac.lk/centers/urc>

According to the new process introduced for the reimbursement of Article processing charges, applicants can get prior approval for the payments before submission of the application. Upon receiving the approval for the APC from URC, usually through an email, submit the invoice for the payment of the APC, and the credit card statement to process the payment.

### Note:

- Application is a fillable form, which you can fill using Adobe Acrobat Reader latest versions.
- Furnish all the details, sign the application, get the Head and the Dean to sign.
- Attach a copy of the complete manuscript and the acceptance letter.
- Only the full-length articles published in SCI/SSCI/SCI-expanded/SSCI-expanded with an impact factor of 2 or higher will be considered for Article Processing Charge (APC).

### Special Note:

- The payment must be done by a permanent staff member of the University of Peradeniya.
- If two authors claim for the same article fill in two separate applications and send both applications together (Attaching one copy of the manuscript and the invoice is adequate). If one author paid for the APC, a consent letter from the second author should be submitted.
- Funding is subjected to availability of funds.



## Research Publication Facilitation Fund [RPFF] University of Peradeniya

The University Research Council [URC] is pleased to announce that it has initiated a scheme to provide financial assistance up to a maximum of USD 1000.00 per year for the researchers of University of Peradeniya to facilitate publishing their research findings in high-ranking peer reviewed journals.

### Financial Assistance:

USD 500 per author up to a maximum of USD 1000 per paper per year.



### Eligibility Criteria:

The applicant should be a permanent staff member of the University of Peradeniya and one of the authors of the journal article.

The University of Peradeniya should have been identified as the sole affiliation or one of the affiliations. Journal articles which do not carry the University of Peradeniya as an affiliation are not eligible for funding.

The journal should be indexed in one of the following Web of Science indexes:

- o Science Citation Index Expanded (SCIE)
- o Social Sciences Citation Index (SSCI)
- o Arts & Humanities Citation Index (AHCI)

The impact factor of the journal should be 2 or higher

The corresponding author of the journal article should have used the institutional e-mail address (pdn.ac.lk or any variant)

None of the applicants should have used this facility within the current calendar year

The URC reserves the right to amend the eligibility criteria. The article processing charge will be reimbursed subject to the availability of funds.

### Procedure:

The applicant should fill in an application form and submit the same to the Director, URC through the Head of the Department and the Dean of the Faculty along with the original copy of the receipt for the payment of page charges and a copy of the journal article. The article should have been published either online or printed with a valid DOI in the journal within the year of concern. 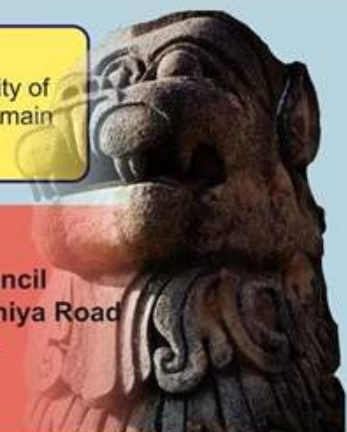
