Abstract Body: (Structured, concise, and informative)

 - o Briefly introduce the research problem or topic.
 - Explain the context and significance of the study.
- **Objectives/Aims/Purpose:** (Up to 50 words)
 - Clearly state the research question or objective(s).
- Methods: (Up to 100 words)
 - Describe the research design, participants (if applicable), data collection methods, and analytical techniques.
 - Be concise, but give enough information to understand the general method used.
- Results/Findings: (Up to 100 words)
 - Summarize the key findings or results of the study.
 - Use specific data or quantitative measures whenever possible.
- Conclusions/Implications: (Up to 50 words)
 - State the main conclusions drawn from the results.
 - o Discuss the implications of the findings for the field or practice.
 - o What does your research add to the current understanding of the subject?
