**Title:** (Concise and descriptive, reflecting the core findings or argument)

**Author(s):** Authors should leave sufficient space in the abstract to add authors' names and affiliations.

**Keywords:** (3-5 relevant keywords for indexing and search)

**Abstract Body:** (Structured, concise, and informative)

- **Background/Introduction:** (Up to 50 words)
  - Briefly introduce the research problem or topic.
  - Explain the context and significance of the study.
- **Objectives/Aims/Purpose:** (Up to 50 words)
  - Clearly state the research question or objective(s).
- **Methods:** (Up to 100 words)
  - Describe the research design, participants (if applicable), data collection methods, and analytical techniques.
  - Be concise, but give enough information to understand the general method used.
- **Results/Findings:** (Up to 100 words)
  - Summarize the key findings or results of the study.
  - Use specific data or quantitative measures whenever possible.
- **Conclusions/Implications:** (Up to 50 words)
  - State the main conclusions drawn from the results.
  - Discuss the implications of the findings for the field or practice.
  - What does your research add to the current understanding of the subject?
