

iPURSE Conference – E-Poster Presentation Guidelines

Design and Format

1. **Slide Format:**
 - All E-Posters must be created using a **single PowerPoint slide in 4:3 landscape orientation**.
 - Posters will be displayed on monitors set to this format.
 - Do **not include animations, transitions, or videos**.
2. **Content Layout:**
 - All content (text, figures, tables, charts, and images) must fit within a single slide window.
 - Use **clear and concise visuals** that are legible from a distance.
 - Organize content logically to effectively communicate your research.
3. **Color and Readability:**
 - Use **contrasting colors** to enhance readability.
 - Apply **dark, saturated colors on a light background, or bright colors on a dark background**.
 - Avoid using similar or low-contrast color combinations.
4. **Fonts and Text Size:**
 - Recommended fonts: **Times New Roman, Calibri, Verdana, or Arial**.
 - Minimum font size: **14 pt** (larger is encouraged for headings and key content).
5. **Disclosure Statement:**
 - Include a brief statement disclosing any potential **conflicts of interest**.
6. **File Size:**
 - The final file must be under **20 MB** for upload.

Presentation Instructions

- Presenters must:
 - Arrive at the allocated hall **at least 15 minutes** before the session starts.
 - **Submit the final poster slide** before the session begins.
 - **Present their poster within a 3-minute time slot**, followed by a **joint Q&A** session with other presenters.
 - Be **prepared to discuss and answer questions** regarding the study during the session.
 - **Display the abstract number, title, and author(s)** clearly on the poster.
 - **Acknowledge research sponsors**, if applicable.
